HISTORY SERVICE FEDERATIONS



In 1972, when representatives of 26 co-operatives met in Churchill, Manitoba they wanted to work together and pool their buying power in the purchase and transportation of merchandise for Co-op retail stores. Canadian Arctic Co-operative Federation Limited (CACFL) was formed.



In 1982, CACFL joins with Canadian Arctic Producers Co-operative Ltd. (CAP), an art marketing Co-operative and forms Arctic Co-operatives Ltd.



The NWT Co-operative Business Development Fund (CBDF), now called the Arctic Co-operative Development Fund (ACDF), was incorporated in 1986.




COMMUNITY CO-OPERATIVE

SAMPLE ORGANIZATIONAL CHART




ARCTIC CO-OP SYSTEM




